

How to Use Elsevier ScienceDirect Pay-Per-View Prepaid Service



You can download individual articles from Elsevier journals that are not included in the Library's subscription. After pre-registration, follow the procedure below for use.

Procedure for Use

	<p>Access ScienceDirect website, and click "Sign in."</p> <p>Log in with the registered username (email address) and password. (https://www.sciencedirect.com/)</p>
	<p>Once you log in, a window will pop up asking to choose your organization. Select "Osaka University, Prepaid," to use the Pay-Per-View prepaid service.</p> <p>* This window will not be displayed if registration is not completed.</p>
