What is Scopus? **Scopus** is the largest abstract and citation database for peer-reviewed literature covering the fields of science, technology, medicine, social science, and arts and humanities. Scopus also covers 100% MEDLINE. Preprints are now searchable. It can be used not only for literature search but also for performance evaluation of researchers and research institutions, for example, World University Ranking, THE or QS use the citations of Scopus data. After this training, you can decide which journal to be submitted by journal metrics or manage your research achievement by the author profile using Scopus.
